The **Bank on Dallas** program will provide financial education opportunities to help enable you to manage money, begin saving, and build wealth and assets.

- Financial education classes may be directly available from banks and credit unions participating in the *Bank on Dallas* program.

Also, non profit partners of *Bank on Dallas* offer free financial education classes in Spanish and English. These classes will teach you about banks and credit unions, how to budget your money, how to manage checking and savings accounts, and how to improve your credit score.
