Smith and Wesson 9mm serial #fy7706 loaded with 15 live rounds one in the chamber found in the back passenger compartment floor board. Jimenez Arms 9mm serial #302446 loaded with 9 live rounds one in the chamber found in the trunk. Both firearms where seized and placed into Baylor street property room for protective custody on gun tag #191276g by Officer T. Park 11331. A set of keys was also found in the back seat of the 2010 Chevy and placed into Baylor Street Property room on property tag#276252B. The 2010 Chevy was towed to city pound by contract wrecker. The weight of the green leafy substance believed to be Marijuana alone was 68.0 grams. The total weight of the drug evidence tag and all of its contents was 747.1grams. The green leafy substance believed to be Marijuana was placed in the Baylor Street Property Room on drug tag 047514D by Arresting Officer Victoria Cordero #11026. Arrested Person Brown, Kendrick was positively identified by his photo on Dallas County Jail records AIS #2913344. A check of TLETS and JI55 revealed enhanceable convictions. A subject check of Arrested Person Brown, Kendrick revealed 2 outstanding warrants out of Grand Prairie PD totaling \$522.00 bond which were confirmed by Hailey with Grand Prairie PD and 4 outstanding alias warrants out of Dallas PD totaling \$1820.26 bond which were confirmed by Keshorn Glenn. The listed Hyundai Sonata was impounded and towed to the City of Dallas auto pound by contract wrecker. Arrested Person Brown, Kendrick was searched by Arresting Officers B. Dombrowski #11135, Jesus Palomo #10887, and again by B. Dombroki #11135 at the jail. Arrested Person Landon, Ricky was searched by Arresting Officers Darius Johnson #11693, Dean Catanzaro #10764, and Jesus Palomo #10887 at the jail. Both Dallas Police squad cars involved in transport of the prisoners were searched prior to start of shift and after transport of both prisoners.
