RP Hiscox stated that Suspect Birstein, Kiesa Dawn entered the location at approximately 8:30pm with a large black and white tote bag. RO's advised RP Hiscox that since Susp Birstein was not found in direct possession of the drugs, they would need to see surveillance video of the bag from the time Susp Birstein set the bag down to the time it was recovered by RP Hiscox. The staff on duty at the time RO's were present only had access to three of the available store cameras and only caught video of Susp Birstein entering with the tote bag.
