Public's Assistance Needed in Identifying Murder Suspect

On August 17, 2013, at approximately 1:36 am, officers responded to a disturbance call at 2000 Greenville Avenue. Upon arrival officers found the complainant, Terrell Cowherd B/M/26, stabbed. The complainant was transported to Baylor Hospital, by Dallas Fire and Rescue, where he was pronounced deceased. Detectives have been unsuccessful identifying the suspect and thereby request the public's assistance.

The suspect is seen below wearing dark pants and no shirt. He is described as a Black/Male/20's, approximately 5'09" and 170lbs. He has tattoos of wings on both of his shoulder blades, as well as other tattoos on his arms.



The pictures below are of a person of interest. He is decribed as a B/M/20's, approximately 5'08"-5'10" and 160-180lbs. He is believed to have gold teeth.
