Ms. Bean, the two critical missing children, and Chelsea McNatt met investigators at a location within the city of Dallas. The children appeared healthy and will be transferred to CPS after being interviewed. Ms. McNatt, who was found to be 16 years old, is being held on a runaway charge out of Balch Springs. Ms. Bean is still being interviewed by investigators. The investigation continues.
