## Dallas Police Receive Donation from DFW New Car Dealers Association

Members of the DFW New Car Dealers Association will be at the Dallas Police Headquarters building on Friday, September 30, 2016 to present Chief David O. Brown with 14 brand new Chevrolet Tahoe vehicles and an additional \$1 million worth of equipment for officers.

This is the largest donation the DFW NCDA has made since its inception six years ago. The group felt compelled to help the Dallas Police Department following the July 7<sup>th</sup> ambush.

Dallas Police Chief David O. Brown said, "We are so thankful to the New Car Dealer Association for such a generous gift. These vehicles and the additional donation for protective equipment will be used by officers assigned to our patrol emergency response teams who respond to some of the most critical and dangerous incidents in the city. The public will also have an opportunity to view these specially equipped vehicles when they are displayed at special events such as National Night Out and Chief on the Beat. Support from stakeholders in our community is what helps keep our officers safe and what makes Dallas the safest city in the country."
