Incident on La Cosa Drive

The Dallas Police Department has received several media inquiries about an incident that occurred on August 25, 2018. Both the Police and Fire Departments are investigating this incident to ensure proper procedures were followed. The Dallas Police Department strives to provide Service First to not only our community but also to our fellow first responders. A timeline of this incident is listed below.

On August 25, 2018, at 23:47 p.m., Dallas Police received a call regarding a male at the location possibly violating a Protective Order. The call was originally coded as a Priority 2.

- 23:48 Call was changed from a Priority 2 to a Priority 1 by a 911 call-taker based on additional information.
- **23:49** Call changed from a Priority 1 to a Priority 2 by the dispatcher for reasons that are currently being reviewed by the department.
- 23:54 Call changed from a Priority 2 back to a Priority 1 by the Dispatch Sergeant based on the review of the call sheet.
- 23:55 Engine 56 requests DPD emergency assistance.
- 23:58 Engine 56 reports male chasing DFR with a knife, requesting DPD emergency assistance. DFR also requests Richardson PD.
- 23:58 Call is announced over the air by the DPD dispatcher.
- 23:59 Patrol Sergeant is enroute to call.
- 00:04 First Patrol element arrives at the apartment complex along with 2 DFR ambulances.
 Suspect subsequently placed into custody. Richardson PD responds shortly thereafter for mutual support.

Thankfully, no one was injured during this incident. This is an ongoing investigation by the Dallas Police Department.
